*A Reading Bingo Card for the Home Library Archive*

Pick a row, column, diagonal, or four corners. Read books from the archive that fit each category — note the title in each square as you go. Five-in-a-row counts as a win; the full card means you know the collection.

## Suggested fills

Stuck on a square? Some books in the current archive that fit several of these categories: *Adventures of Huckleberry Finn* (1918 — read in school, 19th-century, originally serialized), *Six of Crows* (heist plot, fictional city, begins a series), *Berserk Deluxe Edition* (manga, translated, illustrations), *Alchemised* (over 1,000 pages, debut novel), *The Essential Book of Black Holes* (non-fiction, hardcover, includes illustrations).
